- (c) Discuss the significance of the history of Mecca for Muslims today. [6]

- 2 (a) State **four** ways in which Khadija supported Muhammad (pbuh) before his prophethood. [4]
- (b) Describe the events of the first revelation given to the Prophet (pbuh). [10]
- (c) Discuss why the Prophet (pbuh) did **not** preach publicly at the beginning of his prophethood. [6]
