I've worked with musicians from all over the world. Of everything I've done, playing in the band on a TV talent show has been one of my favourites. We played a huge variety of music and got to meet the performers and judges. I also particularly enjoyed playing for a film about dinosaurs. The music was brilliant.

When I first started working, I had to look for adverts in magazines to find jobs but now everything's online, which is much easier. Despite working with famous people, I'm glad I'm not famous, because I don't get too much attention from the media. If anyone asks me about becoming an independent musician, I always explain that I had singing lessons and they really helped. In the pop music industry, we're often asked to do bits of singing on recordings. Also, reply to job offers quickly, or you might miss a great chance.
